Achieving Perfect Scores at District One

YUMA, AZ - Yuma School District One congratulates 11 students for achieving perfect scores on the 2021 AzM2 state standardized test for mathematics and english language arts. Representing eight schools, their achievement demonstrates the academic excellence and exceptional education that students receive at District One schools.

Each year in the spring semester, Arizona public school students in 3rd through 8th grade complete the Arizona state standardized test known as AzM2. These grade-level tests are one way that students demonstrate mastery in reading, writing, and mathematics. A perfect score on these tests is not required to indicate mastery. Rather it demonstrates excellent achievement and outstanding knowledge in grade-level english language arts and mathematics. District ONE Superintendent, James Sheldahl, congratulates students on their outstanding achievement, recognizing, “In a year of unprecedented challenges, they were able to focus and excel.”
