

Make a Difference

Did you know...

You can support extracurricular activities in Arizona schools and receive a tax credit at the same time?

Arizona Tax Credit funds help pay for programs ranging from **sports** and **band** fees to lab **sciences** and **art** projects. It also helps with **travel**, uniforms, **equipment**, extra materials, **field trips**, and **MORE**...

Yuma School District One is committed to maintaining these activities for the enjoyment and enrichment of our students. Unfortunately, our funding is not sufficient to offset all of the associated costs. As a result, these programs must depend on fees from students. And that's where you can make a difference.

Frequently Asked Questions

What does it cost me?

NOTHING! It is simply your decision to give the money to a school of your choice or the Arizona Department of Revenue.

Do I have to have children enrolled in school?

No - any household may donate up to \$400* to be used for extracurricular activities.

Do I take this as a donation or a credit on my Arizona Income Tax Return?

As a credit. Use Form 322 to take the full amount of your donation as a dollar-for-dollar credit agains taxes you owe.

* \$200-Single / \$400-Married filing jointly

Do I have to donate \$400*?

No - Any amount you donate up to \$400* can be used as a credit against your tax liability

As a District One employee, can I donate through payroll deduction? Yes! Please obtain a form from your payroll specialists.

What if I don't owe any taxes when I file?

The credit may only be used to the extent it reduces your tax liability to zero. Any unused amounts may be carried forward up to 5 years.





Arizona Tax Credit

Arizona allows state income taxpayers to receive a tax credit of up to \$400 (\$200 for single filers and \$400 for joint filers) for contributions made to public schools to support extracurricular activities. This tax credit is available to all taxpayers whether or not they have children in the public schools.

The kind of programs you can help fund range from sports and band fees to lab sciences and art projects. Yuma School District One is committed to maintaining these activities for the enjoyment and enrichment of our students. Unfortunately, our funding is not sufficient to offset all of the associated costs. As a result, these programs must depend on fees from students. And that's where you

To claim your Arizona State Tax Credit, just make a donation in an amount you feel comfortable contributing. Whatever amount you give will be offset by a dollar-for-dollar tax credit for the applicable tax year—up to \$400 per tax return! The schools and programs you support are entirely your choice. The law simply states that your donation must go directly to a local school to be used for its extracurricular activities.

By making an Arizona Tax Credit donation, everyone wins. Schools receive the money for extracurricular activities, and donors receive a dollar-for-dollar tax credit (NOT a deduction).

How Are the Funds Used?

Arizona Tax Credit funds help pay for travel, uniforms and equipment. It also helps with extra materials, field trips... just to name a few.
